

## Information on your destination Hapimag London

### Getting there

#### Getting there on your own steam

##### Underground (Lancaster Gate station):

The underground station Lancaster Gate on the Central Line is near the Hapimag Resort London. From this station you can reach the resort by foot as follows: When you come out of the station turn right along Bayswater Road and continue for around 200 m. Then turn right into Lancaster Gate. Take the first street on the left. Continue to the Hapimag resort, which is situated on the right-hand corner of the next crossroads.

##### From Heathrow Airport:

Option 1: Take the Heathrow Express or Connect\* train to Paddington station. When you exit the station, turn right onto the main road (Praed Street) and walk along the street (now Craven Road) until you reach Craven Terrace. Turn left into Craven Terrace (one-way street) and then turn right at Lancaster Gate. Continue to the Hapimag resort, which is situated on the right-hand corner of the next junction.

Option 2: Travel on the underground on the Piccadilly Line as far as Holborn Station and then change to the Central Line and travel to Lancaster Gate station. Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground.

\*Heathrow Express – every 15 minutes

\*Heathrow Connect – every 30 minutes

##### From Gatwick Airport:

With the Gatwick Express or Southern\*\* train travel as far as Victoria Station. Then there are two options.

Option 1: Take the underground, either the Circle or District Line to Notting Hill Gate, then at Notting Hill Gate change to the central line and travel as far as Lancaster Gate station. Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground.

Option 2: Take public bus no. 148 as far as Leinster Terrace. This stop is the closest to the resort.

\*\*Gatwick Express – every 15 minutes

\*\*Southern – approx. every 20 minutes

##### From Stansted Airport:

Take the train (Stansted Express\*\*\*) to Liverpool Street station. Then switch to the Central Line (underground) and travel as far as Lancaster Gate station. Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground.

\*\*\*Stansted Express – every 15 minutes

##### From City Airport:

Take the Docklands Light Railway to Bank. From here, continue by underground to Lancaster Gate station on the Central Line. Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground. This is not the most direct route, but the simplest with luggage.

From Luton Airport:

Take the Green Line bus no. 757 or Easybus to the Marble Arch stop. From Marble Arch you can take the underground and travel as far as Lancaster Gate (1 stop). Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground.

Or take the train from Luton to Kings Cross. From there take the underground to Oxford Circus station (Victoria Line). Then switch to the Central Line and travel as far as Lancaster Gate station. Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground.

## **Rail**

From all stations take the underground to Lancaster Gate station on the Central line. Then proceed as described in the section for getting there by underground.

## **Car**

Drive towards Central London then towards the West End and Marble Arch. From Marble Arch follow the signs to "The West". You will find yourself on Bayswater Road. Continue and then turn right into Lancaster Gate Street. We advise against arriving by car. The Hapimag Resort London does not have its own car park and parking fees in London are high. In addition, the fact that you have to drive on the left makes things difficult for visitors from abroad. The area is also subject to heavy traffic.

Note that there is a congestion charge of GBP 15.00 and every day to be paid between 07.00 - 22.00. Our resort is situated outside the congestion charge zone. You can pay the congestion charge on the internet ([www.cclondon.com](http://www.cclondon.com)) or by telephone (+44 845 9 00 12 34) using a credit card up to 90 days in advance.

With navigation system (GPS): N51° 30' 43"- W0° 10' 47".

## **Arrival outside reception opening hours**

If you arrive outside of reception opening hours, we will leave the key card for your holiday apartment in the so called "Digibox".

1. You will find the Digibox at the main entrance door.
2. Enter the last four digits of your membership number and press the # button. Your membership number is on the booking confirmation.
3. Open immediately the box indicated and take out the key card and use it to open the main entrance. The key card also gives you access to your holiday apartment.
4. You will find an envelope with further information for you in the entrance area.
